

Game of Logging Workshop Registration



What to Bring

- Sturdy boots
- Warm clothes
- Lunch and beverages
- Hardhat with eye and ear protection—all participants must bring a hardhat—the instructor can provide eye and ear protection if participant does not have it.
- Chaps*
- Chain saw** (recommended for Level II and III, if you own one.)

*Our instructors have a limited supply of chaps available for use during training sessions. Please call in advance if you would like to borrow one of these items. We recommend that you wait on purchasing new equipment until after the first day of training.

**If you do not own a chainsaw, just let us know. Participants often use the instructor's saw during GOL I and II.

Start Time and Directions to Site

Bad Weather

Classes are held in most weather conditions, but will be postponed in extreme conditions. If weather seems threatening, participants should call the VFF office (802 453-7728) early in the morning of the workshop. A recording will let you know if the workshop is postponed or cancelled. If there is no such recording, the workshop is proceeding as scheduled.

We schedule a rain date for most training sessions. Please be sure to book off the rain date as well as the actual course date.

In the highly unlikely event that both the regularly scheduled workshop and the rain date workshop are cancelled, you may either apply your registration fee to another GOL training course offered through Vermont Family Forests, or you may receive a full refund.

Refund Policy

We require payment in full upon registration. You may cancel your registration up to two weeks prior to the workshop date and receive a full refund, less a \$25 administration fee.

Cancellations made less than two weeks prior to the workshop will not be eligible for refund, unless we have someone on a waiting list who can fill your space, in which case you will receive a full refund, less a \$25 administration fee. If a workshop is postponed due to rain, participants are expected to attend the workshop on the scheduled rain date.

In the event that we do not have enough registered participants to cover workshop costs, we will cancel the workshop. In the event of such a cancellation, we will issue a full refund to all registered participants.
